**100+WOMEN WHO CARE-PALM BEACH/BROWARD CHAPTER  
MAKES DONATION TO PROJECT LIFT**

The growth of this organization is due to the simplistic platform of fund raising and awareness of those making a difference in our communities. The organization meets quarterly with their members who sponsor local charities, donate \$100 per meeting, vote on their charity of choice, and announce the elected charity to receive the direct donation between four counties Broward, Miami-Dade, Palm Beach and Martin.

100+ Women Who Care is not only attracting members, but has just had their Matching Grant renewed for 2016 by The Richard M. Schulze Foundation who will be aiding recruitment efforts by matching \$200 to each new membership's \$100 donation. Melody Spano, founder of 100+ WWC South Florida has commented, " On behalf of 100 Women Who Care South Florida and our chapter leaders we are truly touched by this opportunity. We are excited to share this news with the upcoming organizations that will directly benefit from this grant".

100+Women Who Care started with 30 ladies (one Chapter) at their first meeting and two years later, they have increased their membership to over 300 women, four chapters and they have raised over \$200,000 for LOCAL non-profits – they keep the funds in the local community.
