Title: Development Manager, Palm Beach County

Location: Palm Beach County/Project Lift Belle Glade Location

Reports to: Chief Impact Officer (CIO)

This can be a hybrid position, working 2 days per week on site at Project LIFT Belle Glade, and 3 days per week remotely.

SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITIES:

Create and implement a strategic fundraising plan for Project LIFT's Belle Glade location, cultivating existing and new donor relationships. The Development Manager will plan and manage Project LIFT Palm Beach County special events and represent Project LIFT in the community.

SPECIFIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Provides and performs program delivery functions including the following:

- In partnership with the CIO, establish and meet annual fundraising goals.
- Plan and implement fundraising events, donor cocktail parties, etc.
- Conduct and manage donor tours, presentations and follow up.
- Provide content relevant to the Project LIFT Belle Glade site to the Marketing Specialist for use in newsletters, donor solicitations, and social media.
- Assist CIO with grant writing and reporting for Project LIFT Belle Glade.
- Research, cultivate, and maintain database of new funding sources, including corporations, foundations, and individuals.
- Represent Project LIFT at community meetings and event as needed, some evenings/weekends may be required.
- Identify, cultivate and recruit potential Palm Beach County Board Members
- Perform other duties as requested.

- Ability to work independently and meet goals with limited daily supervision.
